## Bruno Pelletier-Bacquaert

**Bruno Pelletier-Bacquaert** was born in Paris, France in 1960. He grew up in a musical family (his father played with gypsy guitarist Django Reinhardt) and was encouraged at an early age to develop his musical talent as a composer and instrumentalist. First instruments included the piano, various flutes, and then the guitar. He studied guitar and Jazz Composition at the University of Miami, FL with Randall Dollahon & Ron Miller. Also studied with John Hart, Dave Creamer, Barry Harris & film-scoring with Laurent Petitgirard. Bruno moved to San Francisco in 1987 where he works as a free-lance guitarist and band leader--with performances at the world-renowned Jazz club "Yoshi's" with his own Quartet, at the SF Museum of
