Day 1 – Welcome Reception

A **Barbary Coast Dixieland Band** performs festive arrangements of Dixieland and traditional jazz music. Costumed in red vests, straw hats, bow ties and sleeve garters, they look as good as they sound. The instrumentation may feature banjo, trombone, clarinet, piano, tuba, drums, cornet, saxophone and vocals.



Greeting guests will be a wild array of colorful San Francisco themed characters:

- **San Francisco Mimes** - Clad in festive and flashy attire, these silent characters elicit smiles as they entertain your guests.
- **Jugglers** - One or two jugglers involve the audience in their comic tricks, showing dexterity with pins, balls, knives, or even torches.
- **Strolling Magician** circulates and performs feats of prestidigitation (sleight of hand) for one small group of guests after another. Performances amaze, amuse and astound any onlooker!
- **Captain Byrde**, everybody's favorite Fisherman's Wharf pirate strolls among guests, arms and shoulders awash with color from his variety of live birds.





- **San Francisco Fran** belts out old San Francisco Favorites all the while donning large San Francisco Skyline headdress.
- **Caricaturists** - Delightful cartoonists create comical likeness of your guests!
- **Face Painters** - Guests will love becoming part of the scene from the "Summer of Love" with their personalized

flower power symbols.

- **Gina Bowla Spaghetti** adorned as a plate full of North Beach pasta, comes complete with hat bedecked with grapes, breadsticks and garlic - she's a-one a-spicy a-meat a-ball!



Day 2 - General Session



Our San Francisco themed opening general session begins with a spectacular rendition of the song "San Francisco", breathtakingly performed by a featured performer from **Steve Silver's Beach Blanket Babylon**, a zany musical spoof of pop culture with extravagant costumes and outrageously huge hats. The show continues with a small sample of some of the different influences of the diverse cultures that make up our City By The Bay.

Following the opening act, **Japanese Taiko Drums** take the stage with a rousing mesmerizing beat, with a combination of traditional and contemporary rhythms, dance, and martial arts that seem to transcend the physical world.





San Francisco's Chinatown is the world's largest Chinese settlement outside of China. Through the audience will parade two whimsical **Chinese Lions**. They weave their way to the front of the room where they complete their trek with shoulder stands in front of the stage.

North Beach, San Francisco traditional Italian neighborhood, has some of the finest Italian food and wine along with wonderful music and dance. **Three Opera Singers** (tenors) will serenade us with music that will make any audience appreciate some of the most beautiful music ever written.



The finale of the show brings in a medley of songs based on San Francisco. In this we will begin with three singers who will present songs such as "Dock of the Bay", "If You're Going to San Francisco", and closing with the hit song "We Built This City", sung by lead singer of The Starship, **Mickey Thomas**. Halfway through this song, the curtain opens to reveal a 10-15 piece **Gospel Choir** who will bring the song to new heights and close the show with the audience on their feet singing and clapping along to this powerful anthem.
